### Project Description:

The Medicine Bow Lodge is located in the Medicine Bow National Forest south of Saratoga. The lodge is privately owned, but is on land owned by the National Forest. This requires the lodge to develop a Master Development Plan for the United States Forest Service.

The Master Development Plan is a planning document that outlines all proposed improvements and new construction at the resort complex. The Plan includes the envisioned improvements for the next 20 years. The Medicine Bow Lodge has fourteen cabins, a bath house, horse corrals and a lodge for their guests. The Master Development Plan includes improvements to the following: existing structures, proposed structures, interpretive trails, fences, corrals and utilities, specifically water and sanitary sewer systems. Also as a part of the Plan, PMPC verifies that the existing water and sanitary sewer systems are adequate for the existing demands on the systems and for the proposed development.
